Soderlund has received numerous prestigious awards and prizes. Many of her works are in private and business collections.

The show is an opportunity for local artists to have their works on exhibit for the Old Farm Day visitors. After Old Farm Day, the art will be displayed at the Fluvanna County Community Center on Route 15 in Fork Union for the rest of October.
